### 1. Enroll Today.

### 2. Take The Placement Tests.

There are three quick online pre-tests that will measure your skills. Each takes about 15 minutes.

### 3. Build Your Skills.

To improve your skills and better your scores, use the free online Courseware from any computer, anywhere, anytime.

### 4. Take The Assessments.

To earn the Credential, you come to WTI to take three proctored Assessments that measure your work and college readiness skills – Applied Mathematics, Locating Information and Reading for Information. Each takes about 1 hour.

### 5. Score 3-3-3 or Better.

That's the minimum score to earn your Credential and the \$20 voucher toward your GED fee. If you come up short, use the online Courseware to improve your scores and then try again.

### 6. Take Work Habits.
